The Crafter's Workshop stencils make great frit stencils!

MATERIALS

Assorted Carolina Frit - Fine GBS-10-100-ICE Ice Clear Sheet Glass - 10 In Sq. GBS-10-200 White Opalescent Sheet Glass - 10" Sq. SM-9815 XL Jumpin' Bean Mold SP-8232 Glas Tac TCW157 Flower Frenzy - 12" X 12" Template

SUPPLIES

Detail Paint Brush Hairspray Plastic Spoon Toothpick Water

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Lightly spritz the White Opalescent glass blank with hairspray to give the surface tackiness.
- 2. Position the stencil flat onto the glass base.
- 3. Apply an even layer of assorted fine Carolina Frit over the stencil design areas using a small plastic spoon.
- 4. With the stencil still in place, apply pinpoints of Glas Tac to secure the frit within the open design areas.
- 5. Very gently lift the stencil from the glass base, ensuring the frit design areas stay intact.
- 6. If needed, use a toothpick or a small paintbrush to touch up any design areas. Allow project to dry completely.
- 7. Cap the project with a sheet of Clear Transparent.
- 8. Full fuse using Spectrum's 6-segment firing schedule.
- 9. Once fired, slump project in the XL Jumpin' Bean Mold.
