



# Wintry Mix

Crafter's Workshop stencils make great frit stencils! Create this wintry bowl in just a few easy steps.

## MATERIALS

CF-132-F Carolina Frit Light Blue Transparent - Fine CF-200-M Carolina Frit White Opalescent - Medium CF-533-2-F Blue Topaz Carolina Frit - Fine GBC-10-W01 Clear Sheet Glass - 10 In Circle PT-540 PAPYROS Kiln Shelf Paper SM-2593 Deep Rim Bowl SP-422 Klyr-Fire Glass Glue TCW164 Flurries - 12" x 12" Template

# SUPPLIES

Angled Cut Straw
Detail Writer Bottle (optional, for glass glue)
Hairspray
Plastic Spoon
Small Paintbrush or Toothpick

### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Lightly spritz the 10" clear circle glass blank to give the surface tackiness.
- 2. Position the Flurries stencil onto the glass.
- 3. Fill in the snowflake design areas of your choice with a mix of fine Light Blue and Blue Topaz frit using a small spoon or angled cut straw.
- 4. Gently lift the template to reveal design.
- 5. Use a paintbrush or a toothpick to touch up design areas as needed.
- 6. Apply a small amount of Klyr-Fire glass glue to the design areas to secure frit.
- 7. Add a light sprinkling of fine Light Blue Transparent, medium White Opalescent, and fine Blue Topaz Transparent frit over the project.
- 8. Light spritz project with hairspray to secure frit in place.
- 9. Contour or full fuse project using the 6-segment firing schedule.
- 10. Once fired, slump project in the Deep Rim Bowl Mold.
