Create this flowery glass tray easily with Crafter's Workshop stencils and Colors for Earth glass paints!

MATERIALS

CF-100-F Carolina Frit Clear Transparent - Fine G332 Deep Cranberry G343 Sapphire Blue G350 Light Cerulean GBS-10-534-2 10" Sq. Violet Transparent Sheet Glass GM3002 Glass Medium PT-540 PAPYROS Kiln Shelf Paper ST-340 Tarheel Tools Running Pliers ST-352 Tarheel Pistol Grip Glass Cutter TCW157 Flower Frenzy - 12" x 12" Template

SUPPLIES

Assorted Royal Aqualon Brushes Detail Brush Paint Pots (3) Ruler Ultra-fine Tip Black Sharpie Marker Water

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use a ruler, Pistol Grip Glass Cutter, and Running Pliers to create a rectangle from the Violet Transparent sheet glass. Score the cut line with a Pistol Grip Glass Cutter, then break along the score line with Running Pliers.
- 2. Position the Flower Frenzy stencil onto the glass. Use an ultrafine black Sharpie marker to trace the desired flower designs. Remove stencil.
- 3. Use a pallet knife to load 3 separate paint pots with small amounts of Deep Cranberry, Sapphire Blue, and Light Cerulean.
- 4. Mix in a small amount of Glass Medium into each paint pot until you achieve a heavy cream consistency. Start with a few drops of Glass Medium and add a little bit at a time as needed.
- 5. Use the combination of glass paint colors to fill in the traced design areas. Allow project to dry completely.
- 6. Overlay project with a layer of fine Clear Transparent Frit.
- 7. Contour fuse using the 6-segment firing schedule.
- 8. Once fired, slump project as desired.
