

# Cosmic Colors

# Design courtesy of Slumpy's

Create this pretty project in just a few simple steps using Crafter's Workshop stencils and Glassline paints! If cutting circles is a challenge, this design can be just as easily created using square glass bases.

### MATERIALS

GBC-10-W01 Clear Sheet Glass - 10 In Circle GBS-10-132 10" Sq. Light Blue Transparent Sheet Glass GL-14 Glassline Pen - Purple PT-540 PAPYROS Kiln Shelf Paper SM-9824 Soup Bowl Mold ST-210 Tarheel Tools Precision Circle Cutter ST-340 Tarheel Tools Running Pliers ST-352 Tarheel Pistol Grip Glass Cutter TCW156 Cosmic Swirl - 12" x 12" Template

### SUPPLIES

Sponge Hairspray Toothpick Water

## INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut a 9.5" round circle from the Light Blue Transparent sheet glass blank using a Precision Circle Cutter, a Pistol Grip Glass Cutter, and Running Pliers.
- 2. Light spritz the Light Blue project base with hairspray to give the surface tackiness.
- 3. Position the Cosmic Swirl stencil onto the glass base.
- 4. Sponge Purple Glassline paint onto the open design areas. Once dry, repeat again to achieve 2 coats of color. Let dry.
- 5. Once dry, gently remove stencil.
- 6. If needed, use a toothpick to touch up any design areas by scratching off excess paint.
- 7. Cap project with a 10" clear circle.
- 8. Full fuse using the 6-segment firing schedule.
- 9. Once fired, slump project in the Soup Bowl Mold.
