



Cosmic Colors

Create this pretty project in just a few simple steps using Crafter's Workshop stencils and Glassline paints! If cutting circles is a challenge, this design can be just as easily created using square glass bases.

MATERIALS

GBC-10-W01 Clear Sheet Glass - 10 In Circle
GBS-10-132 10" Sq. Light Blue Transparent Sheet Glass
GL-14 Glassline Pen - Purple
PT-540 PAPHYROS Kiln Shelf Paper
SM-9824 Soup Bowl Mold
ST-210 Tarheel Tools Precision Circle Cutter
ST-340 Tarheel Tools Running Pliers
ST-352 Tarheel Pistol Grip Glass Cutter
TCW156 Cosmic Swirl - 12" x 12" Template

SUPPLIES

Sponge
Hairspray
Toothpick
Water

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut a 9.5" round circle from the Light Blue Transparent sheet glass blank using a Precision Circle Cutter, a Pistol Grip Glass Cutter, and Running Pliers.
2. Light spritz the Light Blue project base with hairspray to give the surface tackiness.
3. Position the Cosmic Swirl stencil onto the glass base.
4. Sponge Purple Glassline paint onto the open design areas. Once dry, repeat again to achieve 2 coats of color. Let dry.
5. Once dry, gently remove stencil.
6. If needed, use a toothpick to touch up any design areas by scratching off excess paint.
7. Cap project with a 10" clear circle.
8. Full fuse using the 6-segment firing schedule.
9. Once fired, slump project in the Soup Bowl Mold.
