



Hipster Soap Dish

Put your scrap glass to good use with this funky soap dish project!

MATERIALS

Assorted Colored Scrap Glass GBS-8-100-4 Clear Sheet Glass - 8 In. Square OC5-96 Assorted Color Odd-Cuts (optional) PT-540 PAPAYROS Kiln Shelf Paper SM9823 Hipster Wavy Soap Dish SP-8234 GlasTac ST-340 Tarheel Tools Running Pliers ST-352 Tarheel Pistol Grip Glass Cutter ST-356 Tarheel Tools Wheeled Mosaic Cutter

SUPPLIES

Detail Writer Bottle (optional, for glass glue) Nipping Basket Ruler Tweezers

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use a ruler, a Pistol Grip Glass Cutter, and Running Pliers to cut a 6.5" x 5" rectangle shape from the 8" clear glass base. Score each measured line with the Pistol Grip Glass Cutter, then break along each score line with Running Pliers.
- 2. Gather an assortment of colored scrap glass or assorted Odd Cuts. Using a Wheeled Mosaic Cutter, nip pieces of assorted scrap glass into small triangle shapes.
- 3. Arrange the nipped, colored triangles in rows onto the clear glass base in a geometric fashion.
- 4. Once all pieces have been arranged as desired, use pinpoints of Glas Tac glass glue to secure the glass components in place. Allow project to dry completely.
- 5. Contour fuse using the 6-segment firing schedule.
- 6. Once fired, slump project in the Hipster Wavy Soap Dish.
