Hello gorgeous! Use our Earrings and Jewelry Fusing Pod Mold and a touch of dichroic accents to create a one of a kind piece of jewelry!

## MATERIALS

Assorted Fine Carolina Frit GCU-100-I-SRL Clear Iridescent Spiral Cut-Ups DG-USC-96-NDL Rainbow Clear Noodles - Dichroic Glass SM-7022 Earrings and Pendant Fusing Pod Mold SP-8268 GlasTac Gel SP-8302 Bead & Jewelry Tips w/ E6000 Adhesive Package SP-9163 Gold Plated Jewelry Bails - Medium ST-205 Boron Nitride Spray II ST-356 Tarheel Tools Wheeled Mosaic Nipper

### SUPPLIES

Angled Cut Straw Toothpick



### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Prime the Earrings and Pendant Fusing Pod Mold with Boron Nitride Spray prior to use.
- 2. Choose two complimentary colors of transparent fine Carolina Frit.
- 3. Using an angled cut straw as a small spoon to dispense your frit, create concentric teardrop shapes rings within the teardrop-shaped pendant shape on the fusing mold, alternating between the frit colors. Set aside.

TIP: When filling the pendant shape, add each concentric ring of frit layer by layer at a time to avoid mixing. Repeat until you fill the pendant shape to the brim.

- 4. Use a Tarheel Tools Wheeled Mosaic Nipper to nip Rainbow Clear Dichroic Noodles into smaller, square-shaped pieces.
- 5. Use pinpoints of GlasTac to attach the cut Dichroic Noodle pieces to the surface of the Clear Iridescent Spiral Cut-Up. Let dry,
- 6. Position the Spiral Cut-up onto the filled pendant shape, near the larger bottom half.
- Carefully transfer the fusing pod mold to the kiln and full fuse using the 6-segment firing schedule.
- 8. Once fired, use E-6000 Jewelry and Bead glue to attach a medium-sized jewelry bail to the top point of the pendant. Let dry.
- 9. Complete your pendant necklace by adding string, cord, or a chain to the bail.
