



# Serene Reflection

Get creative with glass pre-cuts! This beautiful project combines glass painting and fusing to achieve a stunning piece of art.

### MATERIALS

10" Clear Circle Transparent BA5051 BubbleArt Cerulean Blue BT-540 Thinfire Paper Clear Transparent Frit - Coarse GCU-96527 Koi GM3002 Glass Medium

## SUPPLIES

Paint Brush Paint Pot Palette Knife Water

### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Use a palette knife to fill a small paint pot with approximately a tablespoon of BubbleArt Cerulean Blue.
- 2. Mix in a small amount of Glass Medium into the paint pot until you achieve a thin cream consistency. Begin by adding a small amount of Glass Medium, then add additional drops if needed.
- 3. Use a drop and fill technique to paint the 10" Circle Clear Transparent glass base with Cerulean Blue. Use the paintbrush to drop the paint onto the glass surface, then fill the desired area.
- 4. Assemble and position the Koi glass pre-cut onto the glass base.
- 5. Cap the remaining painted area of the glass base, around the Koi pre-cut shape, with a leveled layer of clear coarse transparent frit. Allow project to dry completely.
- 6. Full fuse using the 6-segment firing schedule.
- 7. Once fired, slump glass piece in the Large Radial Plate Mold.
