

Ornate Drape

Create a unique warm glass bowl for your next party or event. This project features an on trend fusing mold design, plus a drape mold to create a unique household piece of art!

MATERIALS

Assorted Blue and Clear Transparent Frit PT-540 PAPYROS Kiln Shelf Paper SM-25606 Organic Bowl Drape Mold SM-6001 Ornate Fusing Plate ST-205 Boron Nitride Spray II

SUPPLIES

Scissors Spoon

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Prime the Ornate Fusing Plate mold using 3 sprayed coats of Boron Nitride II.
- 2. Place a sheet of Papyros Kiln Shelf Paper in the center of the mold. Press down to get a good measure of the inside shape and size. Cut the sheet of Papyros Kiln Shelf Paper to fit the inside shape of the Ornate Fusing Plate mold. Once cut, position inside the mold.
- 3. Fill the inside of the Ornate Fusing Plate mold with an assortment of transparent blue and clear fine or medium frit. Blend in lighter shades of transparent blue and clear in the inside center of the mold, then towards the outer edge of the mold, concentrate the color to include darker shades of blue,
- 4. Fill the mold to the top rim of the design, then add an additional layer to top it off, as if you were creating an "anthill" of frit.
- 5. Full fuse project using the 6-segment firing schedule.
- 6. Prime the Organic Bowl Drape Mold with 3 sprayed coats of Boron Nitride II. Let dry.
- 7. Once your full fused project has been fired once, remove from the Ornate Fusing Plate mold and center position on top of the drape mold in your kiln.
- 8. Drape project using the 6-segment firing schedule.
